DAY 1: SINGAPORE – CHRISTCHURCH

- Welcome to a unique experience!
- Assemble at Singapore Changi Airport for your pleasant flight to New Zealand – **Christchurch** (Meals on Board)

DAY 2: CHRISTCHURCH – LAKE TEKAPO

- Welcome to **Christchurch** – the “Garden City of New Zealand”
- **Christchurch City Sightseeing:** Hagley Park & Antigua Boatshed, Bridge of Remembrance, Christchurch Cathedral, New Cardboard Cathedral and the Art Deco New Regent St
- Journey down to **Lake Tekapo** - Located in the heart of the Mackenzie District in Canterbury. The lake is a spectacular turquoise colour due to finely ground rock in the glacial melted waters
- Stopover at Ashburton for our lunch at Farmers Corner -
- **The Church of the Good Shepherd** – which is situated on the shores of Lake Tekapo amongst the natural beauty of the lake and the mountains.
- **Bronze Sheepdog** - Close to the Church of the Good Shepherd is a well-known bronze statue of a NZ Collie sheepdog
- Suggested activities/optional tours: Stargazing Tour @ Lake Tekapo where you can explore the Southern Sky using telescope, binoculars and naked eye as your guide show you the amazing New Zealand night sky (Chinese Lunch, Japanese Bento Dinner)

DAY 3: LAKE TEKAPO – MT COOK REGION – CROMWELL – QUEENSTOWN

- **Lake Pukaki** – Is the largest lake in the Mackenzie District, from here you will be able to see New Zealand’s tallest peak, **Aoraki/ Mount Cook**
- Enroute, stop at **High Country Salmon Farm**, hand feed the salmon fish, chance to taste fresh salmon sashimi too (**own expenses**)
- Time will also be available for those passengers that wish to join optional Helicopter flight for a closer view of Mount Cook and its surrounding peaks
- Next, stop **Mrs Jones Fruit Orchard** – New Zealand’s fruits paradise, sample and buy great variety of fresh or dried fruits, nuts and honey

- Arrival into **Queenstown** – The Adventure Capital of the World which is surrounded by majestic mountains and set on the shores of crystal clear Lake Wakatipu (Breakfast, Western Dinner)

DAY 4: QUEENSTOWN

- Choice of **ONE** tour option in Queenstown
 - 1) **Full day Skiing Fun at Cardrona Alpine Resort** – One of New Zealand’s popular ski area
Package includes the followings:

 - Equipment rental (Ski set – Skis, boots & poles or Snowboard set – Snowboard, boots & wristguards)

 - 2 x Group lessons (1020am-1220pm & 1pm-330pm) – Total of 4.5hrs
 - 2) **Nomad Safaris (Safaris of the Scenes – Wakatipu Basin)**
– Starts your day with an adventure safari packed with breath-taking scenery, thrilling 4WD action whilst discovering LOTR filming locations. Following a historic gold mining road up the Arrow River you will cross the river many times to get to the Ford of Bruinen at this point you can indulge in morning tea and try your hand at a spot of gold panning. Enter Skippers Canyon- one of the hidden gems in Queenstown, travel along this historical winding road to Lighthouse Rock, which gives a dramatic lookout over the entire canyon rich in gold heritage. Visit Queenstown Hill private high country farm and take in the spectacular panoramic views over the whole Wakatipu Basin. *(Max 6 per vehicle)* Including Morning Tea & Western Lunch (Breakfast, Western Lunch – Only for Normad Safaris 4WD Tours)

DAY 5: QUEENSTOWN – GIBBSTON – ARROWTOWN – QUEENSTOWN

- **Kawarau Bridge Bungy Centre** – This is the 'World Home of Bungy! This will be the opportunity to experience bungy jump*. For those not jumping, there is the purpose built viewing decks that provide a safe and enjoyable area to witness the beautiful scenery and people doing the bungy jump.
**Bungy jump will be at passengers own expense*
- **Gibbston Valley Winery** - Winery visit + Wine Cave tour which give you the opportunity to learn more about the history of the region and the New Zealand winemaking journey
- Visit the Historic **Arrowtown**, a delightful gold rush village nestled below the beautiful peaks that surround the sparkling Arrow River. Some free time to walk around the village at your own leisure (Breakfast, Chinese Lobster Dinner)

DAY 6: QUEENSTOWN

- Enjoy Queenstown at leisure.
- Suggested activities/optional tours: Full day excursion to Milford Sound located at the Fiordland National Park World Heritage Area, take a four wheel drive adventure into the

heart of the backcountry, sky diving, water rafting, horse riding and many more (Breakfast)

DAY 7: QUEENSTOWN – AUCKLAND – WAITOMO – ROTORUA

- Morning transfer to Queenstown domestic airport for domestic flight to Auckland
- **Waitomo Glow-worm Caves** –The glowworm is unique to New Zealand. Thousands of these tiny creatures radiate their unmistakable luminescent light as the guide will provide informative commentary on the Caves' historical and geological significance. Marvel at Mother Nature's light display as you glide silently through the starry wonderland of the Glowworm Grotto. Meander underground along the Waitomo River and gaze in silence at the myriad of glow worm lights that make up the Glowworm Grotto
- Proceed to **Rotorua** - The heartland of New Zealand’s Maori Culture as well as bubbling mud pools, shooting geysers and natural hot springs (Breakfast, Dinner)

DAY 8: ROTORUA

- Brief morning city sights of Rotorua, stop at the Government Gardens – explore the historic gardens that surround a Tudor-style spa bath house. Have a leisurely walk around the beautiful Lake Rotorua
- **Skyline Rotorua** – Take a leisurely uphill Gondola ride up to **Mt Ngongotaha** for a panoramic view of Rotorua, the surrounding lakes and geothermal areas.
- Enjoy an sumptuous buffet lunch @ **Skyline’s Stratosfare Restaurant & Bar**, featuring a stunning array of freshly prepared buffet and cooked-to-order dishes highlighting locally sourced seafood, meat and produce
- Next, The **Skyline Luge*** is a thrilling ride for all ages and abilities and one of the top things to do in Rotorua. Take off downhill on your luge through twists and turns to a backdrop of dramatic scenery and down through our Redwood forest
- **Te Puia:** Is home to the New Zealand Māori Arts and Crafts Institute and the world famous Pohutu geyser. See the boiling mud pools, native bush and the National Schools of Wood Carving and Weaving. You can also see live kiwi close up and learn how they protect these extraordinary endangered birds.
- **Te Po (Indigenous Evening Experience):** It is a feast of storytelling, entertainment and Maori cuisine. Experience the customs and traditions of Maori, with a traditional powhiri, a warrior’s challenge and a full kappa haka concert. Enjoy traditional hangi cooked food and Maori dishes. After dinner you will board the waka for a journey through the valley under lights. Be awed by the magical evening sights of the geothermal valley. Marvel at the sight of this glorious natural wonder, while your guide entertains you with traditional Māori mythology and stories (Breakfast, Buffet Lunch, Traditional Hangi Dinner)

DAY 9: ROTORUA – TIRAU – MATAMATA – AUCKLAND

- Short stopover at the township of **Tirau** – a well-known tourist stop made famous by the many arts work created out of corrugated iron

- Experience the real Middle Earth with a visit to **Hobbiton Movie Set**, featured in The Lord of the Rings and The Hobbit films. Tour starts with a drive through picturesque sheep farm. Take a look at Bag End, where Frodo and Bilbo's adventure began. Get lost among the hobbit holes and visit the Green Dragon inn, the mill and the Party Tree. Listen to spell-binding tales of how Hobbiton came to be
- Proceed to the beautiful **Red Barn** for lunch, where you will also have the opportunity to do Butter churning experience, after lunch, proceed to a guided tour of the Waikato working dairy farm where you will see the world's largest dairy exporter Fonterra's products begin. You will also gain an understanding of the daily practices of a New Zealand farmer and the importance of farming to the New Zealand economy

(Breakfast, Western Lunch)

DAY 10: AUCKLAND – SINGAPORE
