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### DAY 1: SINGAPORE – CAPETOWN (VIA JOHANNESBURG)

- Assemble at airport for your flight to South Africa

### DAY 2: CAPE TOWN

- Arrive at Cape Town airport via Johannesburg
- Meet your tour guide and embark on a city tour of the “Mother City”, driving past Parliament Buildings, City Hall, The Slave Lodge and the Castle of Good Hope, the oldest surviving colonial building in South Africa and Company’s Garden.
- Visit **Bo-Kapp (Malay Quarter)** and marvel at the ice-cream colours of the quaint Bo-Kaap homes.
- Proceed to **West Coast Ostrich Ranch** and enjoy a fun-filled educational tour of ostrich farming follow by an Ostrich Meat Lunch
- Take the iconic **cable car** to summit the legendary **Table Mountain**, Africa’s Wonder of Nature. Enjoy the crisp air and panoramic views of the city, Atlantic Ocean and the surrounding mountains (Strictly weather permitting)
- Dinner and overnight in Cape Town.

### DAY 3: CAPE TOWN – CAPE PENINSULA – CAPE TOWN

- Enjoy a full-day Cape Peninsula tour, the highlight tour of Cape Town
- Scenic drive through **Sea Point, Clifton Beach** and **Camps Bay** with picture stops at the Twelve Apostles
- Continue to **Hout Bay** where you will enjoy a 30-minute boat trip (weather permitting) to **Duiker Island for seal watching**
- Drive along False Bay to **Cape Point Nature Reserve**.
- Take the Flying Dutchman Funicular to the hillcrest of **Cape of Good Hope** for panoramic views of the lighthouse, rocky cliffs and southern oceans
- Visit **Boulders Beach** - with its wind sheltered bays and safe sandy shores, it is home to a breeding colony of over 2000 endangered African Penguins.
- Return to Cape Town for dinner and the night

### DAY 4: CAPE TOWN

- Resting at the foot of the Boland Mountains, the **Cape Winelands** is a renowned for producing some of the world’s finest wines. The breathtakingly beautiful landscape boasts incredible mountain scenery and numerous luxury wine farms laden with vineyards stretching across lush fertile valleys
- You can look forward to a variety of wonderful activities including: exploring a collection of historic little hamlets

and towns dotting the countryside, sampling a wide selection of world-class wine at a historic Cape Dutch farmstead

- Lunch will be at a winery following by wine tasting
- Return to Cape Town
- Free time to explore Cape Town before tonight’s dinner

### DAY 5: CAPETOWN – VICTORIA FALLS (ZIMBABWE)

- This morning transfer to Cape Town Aripport for our flight to Victoria Falls Airport
- Upon arrival, transfer to hotel for check in and lunch
- In the afternoon, depart for a **Sunset Cruise** on the Zambezi River, which is the prefect end to a day in Victoria Falls. The mighty Zambezi’s tranquil waters above the falls are home to hippo, crocodiles, magnificent birds and other wildlife
- This evening, enjoy Boma Dinner\* – a traditional dinner with local entertainment with drums and dances  
\*Weather permits

In the events hotels in and/or flight out of Zimbabwe are not available, we will stay in Livingstone as an alternative. Tours and activities will have no changes or minimal changes / alteration with major sites not affected

### DAY 6: VICTORIA FALLS (ZIMBABWE)

- This morning, go on a **guided tour** to see the great **Victoria Falls**. Water thunders into the gorge of the Zambezi River creating a mist that keeps the surrounding area permanently wet. The magnificent setting helps make Victoria Falls one of the Seven Wonders of the World. Discover how the Falls were formed and what local customs and traditions surround them. Lastly end the tour with a visit to the **local art and crafts centre**
- Continue to the **Victoria Falls Bridge**, where you will visit the historical railway bridge which is an integral part of any complete Victoria Falls experience. Learn about its fascinating history on this multi-faceted tour. Free entry into the Bridge Visitor Centre where original photographs of the Bridge dating back to the early 1900’s can be viewed too (\*\*Please do bring along your passport with you for today activities)
- Today lunch will be at **Makuwakuwa**, this is an award-winning restaurant that is open on three sides and overlooks the waterhole at Victoria Falls Safari Lodge, offering a unique opportunity to view elephant and other wildlife as you enjoy your meal – truly some of the finest dining in Victoria Falls

- After lunch, the rest of the afternoon would be free at leisure for you to explore more of Victoria Falls

  1. Bungee Jump
  2. 12-15Mins Helicopter Flight

#### DAY 7: VICTORIA FALLS (ZIMBABWE) – LIVINGSTONE – NELSPRUIT – KRUGER NATIONAL PARK

- After breakfast transfer to Livingstone Airport (Zambia) for flight to Nelspruit
- Upon arrival, transfer to Kruger National Park
- Check into our tonight lodge dinner will be in the lodge

#### DAY 8: KRUGER NATIONAL PARK

- Enjoy a morning game drive in an open 4x4 vehicle in search of Africa's Big 5 and abundance wildlife
- Return to lodge for breakfast
- Leisure time for you to rest and relax
- Enjoy lunch at the lodge
- Gather for **afternoon game drive** in search for more wildlife
- Return to lodge for dinner and the night

#### DAY 9: KRUGER NATIONAL PARK – JOHANNESBURG

- Check out of our lodge and start our journey back to Johannesburg
- En route visit the **Panorama Route** and stop at **Blyde River Canyon** –The third largest canyon in the world. **God's Window** – Which looks out over the Drakensberg escarpment dropping 1000m below, offering a view of the lowveld stretching out towards the Kruger National Park. Magnificent montane forest, canyons, rock formations and waterfalls can all be seen. **Bourke Luck Potholes** - The Treur River plunging into the Blyde River has caused waterborne sand and rock to create huge

potholes, some six metres deep, into the bedrock of the river. **Three Rondavels** – Which is famous for its view of the 33 kilometre long gorge that forms the Blyde River Canyon

- Lunch will be at a local restaurant
- After lunch, continue our journey to Johannesburg

#### DAY 10: JOHANNESBURG – PRETORIA – JOHANNESBURG

- Arrive at Johannesburg airport
- Explore the capital city **Pretoria**, the city of Jacaranda named for its breath-taking purple-lined streets when the jacaranda trees are in full bloom every October.
- A drive through the city to see **Paul Kruger House, Church Square, City Hall, State Theatre and Opera House** and the **Union Buildings**
- Check into the hotel and the rest of the evening would be free at leisure

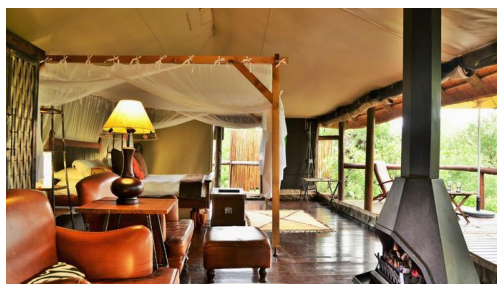
#### DAY 11: JOHANNESBURG

- After dinner, transfer to Airport for our flight back home

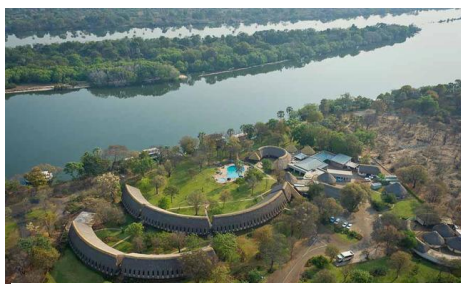

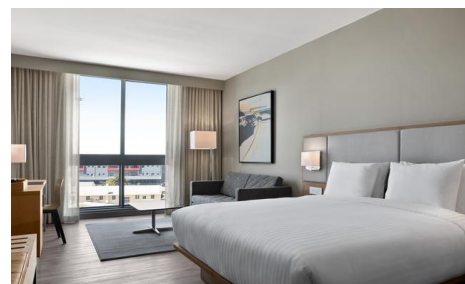
